



Second Report on the 2018 Surrey County Championships

February 10th/11th, SSP



The second weekend of the County Championships, held at Surrey Sports Park, produced multiple medals, performance PBs and many more gutsy swims by Woking swimmers. Whilst we celebrate our incredible medal winners below, we also congratulate all the swimmers who qualified for the County Championships and for some, in their first County Championships, setting some incredible PBs (details below).

Hendrik van der Leest continued his impressive Golden campaign, scooping up an incredible further 4 Gold medals in 200m Free, 200 Fly, 200m Back, 100m Back and a Silver in 100m Breast and setting three new U14 club records along the way in 100m & 200m Back and 200m Fly. In particular, a gutsy finish in the 200m Freestyle, fighting to hold first position all the way down the final length. Brin Dorrell, joined Hendrik to make it a double Woking Gold in 100m back and then taking Silver in 200m Back and Dominic Gunn swam an impressive 200m Freestyle to take Silver.

More medals were to follow with Charlie Wale picking up an impressive Silver in the gruelling 200m Fly, and following one of the most excitingly close finals races, Zoe Ryan taking a well deserved Gold medal in 200IM. Kiera Heney joined 'The Woking Golden Girls' winning the 100m Freestyle in impressive style and finally Anna Maine scooping Silver in the Girls open age group. Special mention for Danel Jansen, who was just pipped into 4th place in her 100m Free final!

The weekend saw Woking swimmers produced some fantastic PBs, and bearing in mind that most entries were Short Course (SC) times and results Long Course (LC) it makes the PBs below even more impressive. In the 200m Freestyle, of note was Mana Tanaka, who dropped 6 seconds, Alice Lockhart 1.5s, Kyarra Steele over 2.5s with both Zoe Ryan and Sophie King also PB-ing. In the 100m fly, a whopping near 6sec PB for Deborah Marango, over 5s for Chizara Elechi, ~2.5 s for Mana Tanaka and -1s PBs for Kyarra Steele and Zoe Ryan.

Sunday saw more PBs tumbling, with 200IM bringing huge PBs for Isabelle Heney (-4.84sec), Chizara Elechi (-3.99sec), Mana Tanaka (-3.84sec), Deborah Marango (-3.65sec), Kyarra Steele (-2.34sec), and Zoe Ryan (-3.65sec) and rewarding Zoe with a finals place and exciting Gold medal finish.

Daniel Baldwin won the best PB of the weekend in 200m Fly, with a whopping -13.94 sec from SC entry to LC finish time, jumping him up the rankings to 12th place followed by Charlie Wale's 4 sec PB to win him his silver medal and Hendrik's -5.53sec to take Gold.

The Weekend also delivered a large number of finalists and thus further congratulations go to those outside the medals but making finals or finishing top 10 – a great achievement :
